The Scripture Stickers™ Missionary Discussion Series is designed to highlight the scripture reference and principles taught in the LDS Missionary Discussions. Missionary Discussion Series Part #1 contains the Lesson Scripture References from all of the Discussions. It also includes the Resource Scriptures from the Instruction on Prayer, Invitations to be Baptized, Referral Invitation and the Invitation to Read the Book of Mormon. Each sticker is numbered and described completely. The scripture reference is then given along with the Discussion number and principle.

SCRIPTURE STICKERS™ INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all instructions carefully before using Scripture Stickers™. Adult supervision is advised. Each Scripture Sticker™ is numbered. A description of each sticker along with its scriptural reference is listed. It is recommended that the sticker be placed directly on the scripture or as close as possible thereto; personal preference to sticker placement, however, is encouraged.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Scripture Stickers™ are manufactured to be as thin as possible. This allows your scriptures to hold hundreds of stickers without getting noticeably thicker. Because the sticker is so thin it is important to remove it from the sticker page slowly and carefully. If for any reason the sticker should begin to tear, stop immediately and remove it from the opposite side. If the cut around the sticker is insufficient for easy removal, use scissors to cut around the sticker.
